Discussion Questions

1. Why do you think Paul was so upset with the Galatians that he called them foolish? What was it about the false doctrine they were embracing that upset Paul so deeply?
2. Paul put the cross at the center of what the Galatians needed to focus on. How much do we consider the cross in our lives?
3. What does it mean to you that the cross is the complete atonement for our sins? Do we ever struggle to accept that there is nothing more for us to do to be right with God than what Jesus has already done on the cross? How have you struggled with that in your Christian walk?
4. Discuss the following descriptions of a Christian based on Galatians Chapter 3:
A Christian is person who is:
 - Shaped by the Cross (v. 1)
 - Indwelt by the Spirit (vv. 2, 5)
 - Carried by Christ (v. 3)
 - Opposed by Darkness (v. 4)
 - Connected to God's Promises (vv. 6-25)
 - Living outside the Box (vv. 26-29)Which of these are easiest for you to comprehend? Which are easiest?
What difference would it make if those descriptions truly characterized us?
